

CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTIONAL CONSERVATION

This is to certify that **777 Ranch** of Hondo, Texas has contributed more than three-hundred thousand dollars directly to *in situ* recovery projects of endangered and CITES listed species in their countries of origin, through funds generated from the *ex situ* species sustainable use and management in Texas. The species that have directly benefitted included Addax, Eld's Deer, Arabian Oryx, Scimitar Horned Oryx, Red Lechwe, Dama Gazelle, and Barasingha. The countries where these species have been protected from poaching, re-introduced, researched, strategically managed and monitored in hundreds of projects over twenty-five years include Namibia, India, Thailand, Cambodia, Burma, Laos, Vietnam, Oman, Chad Saudi Arabia, Jordan, and Zambia. These projects and programs have been coordinated with the IUCN Deer Specialists Group, WWF, TWS of the USA and India, the Smithsonian Research Institute, Conservation Force and many range nation wildlife authorities.

The 777 Ranch is among the leaders and heroes of conservation and recovery of the above listed species and the programs are among the largest and most important for the recovery of those species in the world.
